

BUS TICKETS

You can purchase bus tickets in any tobacco shop (you will see a black and white T sign outside).

- a regular ticket is 0,90 € and is valid for 70 minutes. If you buy a carnet of 10 bus tickets, you will pay just 8 €.
- a daily ticket (“giornaliero”) is valid 24 hours for a cost of 2,30 €, if you buy a carnet of 10 of these tickets, you will 22 €

Remember to always validate the ticket once you step into the bus.

For the cable car from Trento to Sardagna, you just need a bus ticket.

ABBONAMENTO

If you want to ask for a monthly/yearly bus ticket (“abbonamento”) you need to bring the following documents to the ticket office of the blue bus station (just a few meters off the train station, in via Pozzo):

- a passport-size picture (with your signature behind) that will be returned to you
- a request form filled out in all its parts (to get this form and/or to have a help to fill it out, please ask someone of the ECT* staff)
- a document (passport, ID card or driving license)

A *smart card* will be issued and it will be valid for five years.

In order to pay the monthly/yearly bus ticket, you will “charge” this card for the period you are interested to

Prices (last update: June 2008):

- *Smart card*: 4 €
- *Monthly bus ticket*: **21,50 €** (26 if you are more than 30 years old)
- *Yearly bus ticket*: **174,50 €** (211 if you are more than 30 years old)

PRE-PAID CARD

If you do not plan to travel frequently by bus, an alternative to buying single bus tickets is getting a pre-paid card (“tessera scalare”). You can purchase it at the ticket office of the blue bus station (just a few meters off the train station, in via Pozzo) for 4 € and charge it for 10 up to 100 €.

This card is valid also for trains from Trento to Villazzano.

Remember to pass the card in front of the punch-machine, in order to validate your ticket.
