



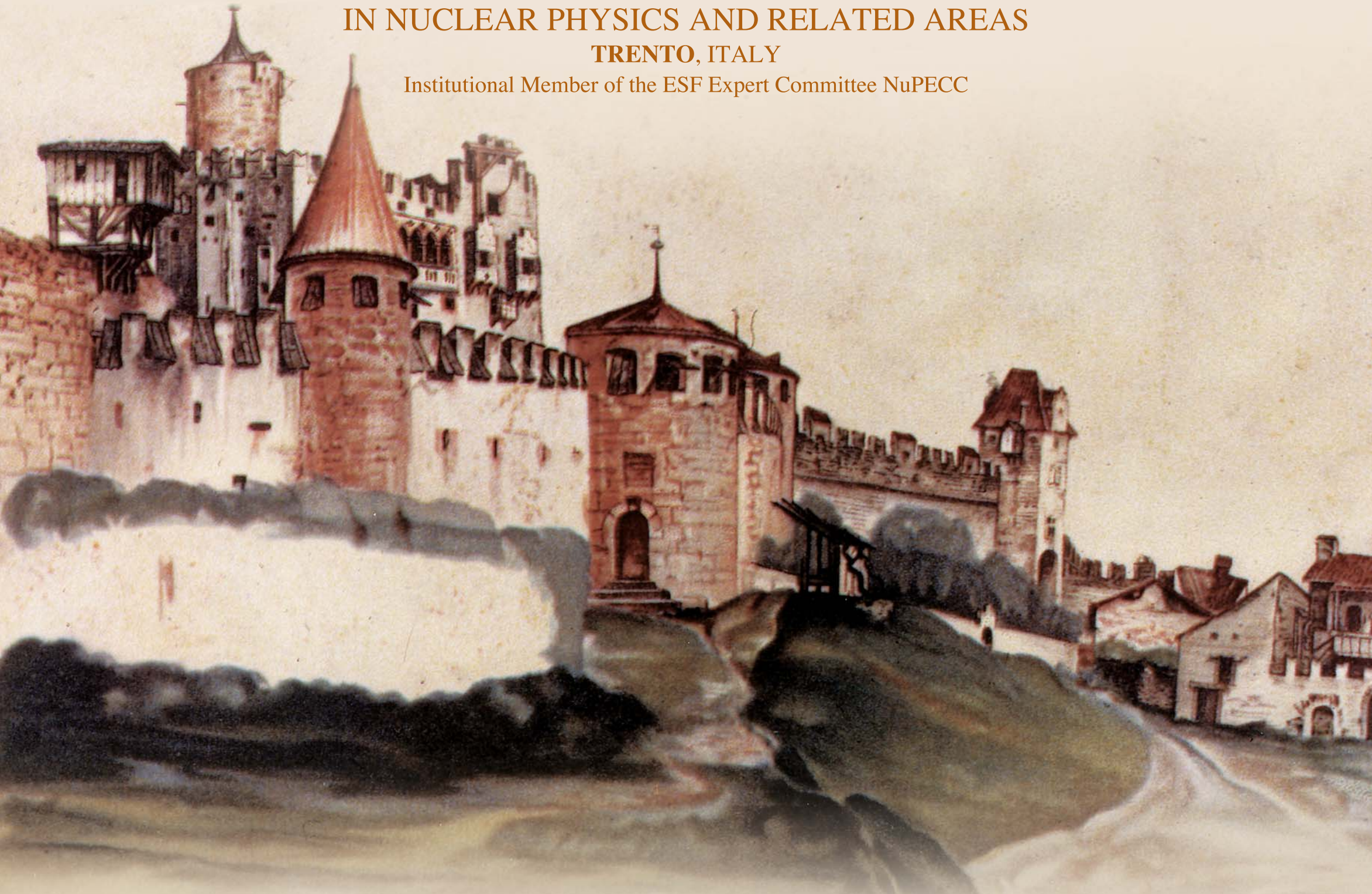

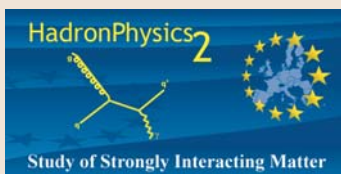
International Workshop on Electroweak Interactions with Nuclei: Scaling and Superscaling Trento, October 26-30, 2009
